Essential Kit List (indoor & outdoor activities)

As we are based on indoor and outdoor curriculums, we will need to be prepared for all eventualities. Therefore, children will need to have the essential items listed below. Please ensure everything has a name label!

Clothing	 Extra set of clothes, extra underwear, and socks, any accidents or mess they get in. Seasonal outerwear to be kept at the nursery.
Winter	 Insulated waterproof trousers and jacket, i.e. ski wear, waterproof dungarees. Example of brand: https://www.polarnopyret.co.uk/, http://www.muddypuddles.co.uk/ https://spottyotter.co.uk/ Waterproof mittens (not gloves) A snood to cover both the neck and head (no scarves) A fleece
Summer	 Thin waterproof sun hat Long cotton sleeved and bottoms (no T-shirts or shorts – this is important as not only protects from the sun and scratches but also ticks) Sunblock - please ensure your child has sunscreen on before they arrive at school for the summer months. Top up creams can be left at the nursery.
Shoes	 Soft indoor shoes: Non-Slip / Slippers (with grip) Outdoor shoes - insulated boots for Winter trainers (no open toed sandals) for Summer Wellies (wet weather)
Forest School	 Work gloves (cut-resistant) Fire gloves Light my Fire Ferro Rod
Backpack	 Backpack (Not only can you pack your child's backpack with the day's necessities, but the teachers can also use it to send home artwork and school notices)
Water Bottle	A named water bottle.
